

# CALL FOR PROPOSALS

## ALASKA BOARD OF GAME **FALL 2005 MEETING\*** **ARCTIC AND WESTERN REGIONS**

The Alaska Board of Game calls for proposed changes in the regulations pertaining to hunting, trapping, and the use of game in the Arctic and Western regions to be considered at the Fall 2005 board meeting. These regions are composed of Game Management Units 18, 22, 23, and 26A.

### **PROPOSAL DEADLINE: 5 P.M., August 19, 2005**

#### **For all species in Game Management Units 18, 22, 23, and 26A:**

Hunting seasons and bag limits including subsistence and general hunts for all species, (but not reauthorization of antlerless moose hunts\*); Trapping seasons and bag limits; Methods and means; Harvest tickets and reports, (but not reauthorization of brown bear tag fee exemption\*\*); Musk oxen tag fees; Big game prey populations and objectives for intensive management; Restricted areas, including controlled use areas, management areas, closed areas, and closures in state game refuges; Areas closed to hunting; Areas closed to trapping; Special permit areas; Permits for taking incidental or stranded musk oxen; Bag limit for brown bears; Units 22 and 23 brown bear permits; Salvage of game meat, furs, and hides; and Species and Areas for taking children hunting prior to regular seasons.

\* Reauthorization of antlerless moose hunts was before the Board of Game at its March 2005 meeting;

\*\*Reauthorization of brown bear tag fee exemption was before the Board of Game at its March 2005 meeting.
