**Board of Game to Meet in Anchorage**

(Juneau) - The Alaska Board of Game (the "board") will meet June 4 - 5, 2005 in Anchorage at the Hotel Captain Cook. The board will consider proposals pertaining to hunting seasons and bag limits for caribou and moose in Game Management Units 11 and 13; required permit hunt conditions and procedures; community subsistence harvest hunt and permit conditions; community harvest hunt areas; salvage of game meat, furs, and hides; and subsistence harvest areas and conditions.

The proposals are the result of continued efforts by the board, the public, state advisory committees, and state and federal agencies to resolve problems associated with the Tier II subsistence hunting system.

The board will begin taking oral public testimony on Saturday, June 4. Anyone wishing to testify to the board must sign up at the meeting site. The deadline for signing up will be announced at the meeting by the Chair. Public testimony will continue until everyone (who has signed up and who is present when called by the Chair to testify) has been given the opportunity to be heard. Written comments on a specific proposal will be accepted up until the time the board begins deliberating that proposal; written comments may be faxed to 907-465-6094, or presented to board staff at the meeting.

Deliberations on the proposals will begin following public testimony and continue through the remainder of the meeting.
