**Alaska Board of Game Announces Date Change  
and Call for Proposals for Spring 2006 Meeting in Fairbanks**

(Juneau) - The Alaska Board of Game is pleased to announce that the dates for the Spring 2006, Interior region meeting have been changed to better accommodate the public. The meeting, which will be held at the Fairbanks Princess Riverside Lodge, will begin Friday, March 10 and end on Monday, March 20.

The original meeting was scheduled for Monday, March 13 thru Wednesday, March 22. The weekend start date will provide a better opportunity for public involvement with the Board of Game.

The Board of Game has also issued a Call for Proposals for the spring meeting. The board is calling for proposed changes in regulations pertaining to hunting, trapping, and the use of game in the Interior region, composed of Game Management Units 12, 19, 20, 21, 24, 25, 26B and 26C. **The deadline for submitting proposals is 5:00 pm on December 9, 2005.**
